CURRICULUM

Music in Motion Classes

Music in Motion Classes offer young children the opportunity to discover the joy of making music as individuals as well as members of a group. The classes also provide a foundation for development of musical aptitude by exposing children to a musical environment at the two most critical ages (0-3 years and 4-6 years) for maximum growth to be realized in later years.

Songs, finger plays, dances, circle games, rhythmic exercises, and whole body movement are incorporated into a positive, cumulative musical experience. These activities also strengthen coordination and increase language skills as well as social development. Creative expression is encouraged which stimulates the imagination. The classes are designed so that students can participate continuously from ages 2-5 and enjoy new songs and materials throughout that time.

Classes are for the children only, parents are welcome to wait in the reception area, or go shopping!

2-3 year olds

1 hour per week, maximum number of students per class is 6. Children discover the joy of singing by learning lots of songs while accompanying themselves with various rhythm instruments, i.e., triangles may be played by the children while singing one song; tambourines or sand blocks with another. Rhythm sticks, maracas, drums, castanets, jingle tappers, cymbals, claves, and xylophones also are used. There are songs about summer, dinosaurs, our earth, trains, the beach, boats, horses, teddy bears, and nursery rhymes. *Each week, the children will make a simple rhythm instrument to take home.*

4-5 year olds

1 hour per week, maximum number of students in each class is 8. Learning fun songs, dances, and folk songs while playing various rhythm instruments comprises the majority of class time.

To celebrate America's 250th Anniversary, this summer's classes will discover the rich heritage of American Folk Music. Pioneer songs, patriotic songs and anthems, and western songs will be introduced. Listening selections by American composers will be featured, including *Fugue and Chorale on Yankee Doodle* by McBride, *Rodeo* and *Appalachian Spring* by Copland, *American Salute* by Gould, and *Sea Pieces* by MacDowell. Music craft time provides an opportunity for each student to make and paint several musical instruments to take home! Come join the fun!

Piano/Keyboard Classes for students ages 5 1/2 - 7

New Students: Mondays 3-4 PM or Wednesdays 4-5 PM

These classes provide the foundation for individual instruction to begin at a later age. Children learn to play songs on the keyboard as well as write them on the staff. Rhythmic differentiation, note reading, and music symbols will be introduced. Class size is limited to 6. Access to a piano or keyboard is necessary for practice for the class. Students beginning in the summer have the option of continuing into the Fall Semester, when classes will be held on Tuesdays or Thursdays.

Music Revue for parents and friends will be on **Sunday, August 9.**

Individual Piano and Voice Instruction

Private piano and voice instruction is offered on all levels to adults and children age 8 or older. Most lessons are 1/2 hour weekly and are tailored to meet the individual needs of each student. A 45 minute weekly piano/voice lesson is available also. There will be a **Recital on Sunday, August 9.**

Children's Chorus, for students ages 6-12

A love of singing is the only requirement for joining the Allegro Children's Chorus!

There will be an emphasis on ear training and solfege, as well as instruction on diction and vocal technique. Repertoire will include songs from The Wizard of Oz, rounds, and several fun songs of summer!

Musical Theater Workshops

This program provides an opportunity for exploring many facets of musical theater within a positive, creative environment. A spirit of cooperative camaraderie is encouraged, with the rule of *no making fun at another's expense* strictly enforced. Students learn the process of preparing a musical production by example and experience. Instruction for the development of improvisational skills and movement on stage through theater games is provided as well as vocal technique and solfege. Each class will culminate in the performance of the musicals described below. Admission will be charged for each of the shows to help defray the costs of production, including "live" piano accompaniment for performances (no taped accompaniment). Tickets may be purchased in advance or at the door. There is no minimum number to buy, but it is hoped that everyone will come out to support our cast!

5 - 7 Year Olds: Go Fish! Class meets weekly on **Wednesdays, 5-6 PM**

Come join little Tiger Shark and his many aquatic friends - including Tune-a Fish, Star Fish, a *spotted* Zebra Fish, and a 7- legged Octopus- as they discover how their differences make them special! This musical features easy rhyming dialogue and fun songs such as *We're Sharks!*, *Commotion in the Ocean*, and *The Colors of the Sea!*

8-13 year olds: Bebop With Aesop! Class meets weekly on **Thursdays, 5:30-7 PM**

Creative musical settings with fun & funny dialogue plus rock 'n' roll music dramatize five of Aesop's most famous fables (*Look Before You Leap*, *Don't Count Your Chickens Before they Hatch*, *The Tortoise and the Hare*, etc.) Come explore the timeless wisdom with a modern twist!
